



Application for SCAL-SBF Foundation Compassion Fund

The SCAL COVID-19 Fund was launched on 8 May 2020 by the Singapore Contractors Association Ltd (SCAL) to help the construction sector ride through the COVID-19 pandemic. The Fund provides eligible member firms with temporary relief to ease their financial difficulties. A total of about \$1.12 million has been raised through the generous contributions from SCAL members, with matching funds from SBF Foundation and the Building and Construction Authority, and tapping on the SG Together Enhancing Enterprise Resilience (STEER) programme through Enterprise Singapore. To-date, about 255 SME members have received assistance from the Fund.

In partnership with SBF Foundation, the SCAL COVID-19 Fund has been inaugurated as the SCAL-SBF Foundation Compassion Fund. SCAL is one of the pioneer industry leaders to set up the industry-led Compassion Fund. SCAL members can now apply for the Fund to help provide financial and other support to their employees as detailed below:

- 1) Company eligibility
 - SCAL member (Ordinary/Associate/Trade) or registered trade subcontractor as at 1 April 2020, and
 - Company's group annual sales turnover is not more than S\$100 million OR has an employment size of not more than 200 workers, and
 - Firm is assessed to be in financial hardship
 - As the SCAL-SBF Foundation Compassion Fund comes under the SCAL COVID-19 Fund, therefore, companies that previously successfully applied for and received SCAL COVID-19 Fund will not be eligible.
- 2) Employee eligibility
 - Gross monthly salary \$3,000 and below
 - Experiencing hardships due to sudden, unexpected crisis at personal or family level
- 3) Eligible firms can receive a one-time support capped at \$3,000 to cover the list of supportable items in the table below.
