Selecting a suitable procurement strategy in consideration of the client's objectives is a key to the success of any construction project. The Certificate in Procurement Management provides the course participants an in-depth understanding of the procurement process for construction projects. It covers tendering procedures and the preparation of tender documents. Topics include traditional procurement methods, design & build, management contracting, two-stage tendering, etc., evaluation and award. Preparation of tender documents including writing of specifications and descriptions for works and services will also be covered. This course will deepen the course participants' competencies in procurement planning and management, enabling them to plan and manage various procurement strategies, from sourcing to purchasing of construction goods and services, to meet project expectations. Delivering a project of high complexity within the right cost budget, time schedule and quality is critical in meeting client's project objectives. Cost management and estimating provides project owners, developers, consultants and contractors the certainty and economy of cost over the life cycle of a building with the use of cost modeling, planning and management techniques. The Certificate in Cost Management and Estimating covers the basic principles relating to estimating of items of the works to be undertaken on construction projects. Major topics are quantitative techniques in cost analysis, cost planning and approximate estimating.
