






Use fall restraint equipment

This is **NOT** a FALL ARREST Equipment






Fall protection and fall arrest equipment



Safety harness must be worn and anchored

Electrical panel and tools inspected regularly by licensed electrical worker (LEW)




Use only approved-type plug and socket



Secured distribution board




Generator must be earthed, fenced and locked

Good cable management




Hang up all electrical cable on insulated support




Use of tagline to prevent excessive sway and direct contact


Prevent Fire at Worksite / Storage and Handling of Hazardous Substances



Prevent Fire at Worksite / Storage and Handling of Hazardous Substances



Designated store for chemicals



Designated store for gas cylinders



Chemicals and flammables are stored at designated storage



Gas cylinders must be secured at all times



Check hose connection for leakage



Obey all mandatory, warning and information signs



Obey
"No Smoking"
signs



Attend regular health checks



Proper disposal of hazardous waste



Proper labelling




Adequate ventilation (eg. dilution and extraction)



Regular housekeeping



Understand safety data sheets





Proper use of hearing protectors



Roll: With clean hands, firmly roll entire ear plug between thumb and fingers to form a thin, tight cylinder.



Insert: Using one hand, gently lift top of ear up to open ear canal. With other hand, insert rounded end of ear plug.



Hold: With forefinger, hold ear plug in place for 30 to 45 seconds to form a comfortable, snug fit.



Correct: When inserted correct, the flat side of the ear plug is positioned at opening of the ear canal.



Incorrect: Flat side of ear plug extends beyond opening of the ear canal.









Prevent heat stroke Drink more water

Apply enough soap to cover all hand surfaces.




Rub hands palm to palm

Palm to palm with fingers interlaced




Backs of fingers to opposing palms with fingers interlocked



Rotational rubbing of left thumb clasped in right palm and vice versa




Rotational rubbing, backwards and forwards with clasped fingers of right hand in left palm and vice versa




Rinse hands with water



Dry thoroughly with a single use towel



Protect from haze – wear suitable mask (N95)

Ochoose a small or mediumsized face-piece that fits the face. Pull the head bands loose. The metallic strip should be uppermost. Pass the hand through the head bands.



Put on the mask. The head bands should be around the head and neck.



Press the metralic strip on both sides with the forelingers and middle fingers of both hands.



Seal Check:

Positive pressure checking cover the mask lightly with both hands. Breathe with deliberation. Air should not leak out from the side of the mask.

Negative pressure checking - cover the mask lightly with both hands. Suck in all with deliberation. The mask should depress slightly inward.
